We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of INDIAN PROGRESSIVE PUBLISHING CO.PRIVATE LIMITED which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2017, the Statement of Profit and Loss, the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Standalone Financial Statements

We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and Matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder.

1 NOTES TO ACCOUNTS & SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES 1) SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

i) BASIS OF ACCOUNTING:

The Financial Statements are prepared under historical cost convention, on accrual basis, in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India, the Accounting Standards as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rules, 2006 and the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 Rule 7 of Companies (Accounts) Rules 2014/Companies Act, 1956, as applicable.

All assets and liabilities have been classified as current or non-current, wherever applicable, as per the normal operating cycle of the company as set out in the Schedule III to the Companies Act, 2013.

II) FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION:

Tangible Assets:

Fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition or construction less accumulated depreciation. Cost includes purchase price and all other attributable cost of bringing the assets to working condition for intended use.

Subsequent expenditures related to an item of Tangible asset are added to its book value only if they increase the future benefits from the existing assets beyond its previously assessed standard of performance.

Pursuant to the enactment of the Companies Act 2013, (the 'Act'), the Company has followed the calculation of depreciation in accordance with the provisions of Schedule II of the Act.

Intangible Assets:

Intangible Assets are ammortised over the estimated period of benefit or contractual terms, as applicable.

III) INVENTORIES:

Finished Stock (Books) are valued at average cost price. Raw materials (paper) are valued at cost plus freight (under FIFO) method.

IV) EMPLOYEE BENEFIT:

Short Term Employee Benefit:

All employee benefit payable within twelve months of rendering services are classified as Short Term Employee benefit. Such short term employee benefit are recognised as revenue expenses at its actual amount due in the period in which the employee render the related services.

V) FOREIGN CURRENCY

There is no foreign currency transaction during the year. No assets has been purchased in foreign currency.

VI) REVENUE RECOGNITION:

- i) Sales excludes Sales Tax/VAT, if any.
- ii) Other Income is accounted on accrual basis except where the receipt of income is uncertain.

VII) TAXES ON INCOME:

Current Tax is determined as the amount of tax payable in respect of taxable income for the year.

Deferred Tax is recognised, subject to consideration of prudence, in respect of deferred tax Assets/Liabilities arising on timing differences, being the difference between taxable income and accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent period.

VIII) INVESTMENTS:

Long Term investments are stated at cost less other than temporary diminution in value, if any. Current Investments are stated at lower of cost & fair value.

IX) PROVISIONS AND CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

A provision is recognised when the company has a present obligation as a result of past results and it is probable that an outflow of resourcecs embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation. Provisions are recognised at the best estimate of the expenditure required to settle the present obligation at the balance sheet date.

A disclosure for a contingent liability is made when there is a possible obligation or a present obligation that may, but probably will not, require an outflow of resources.
